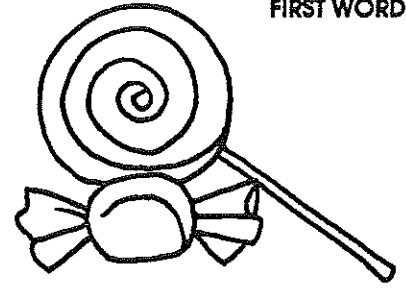

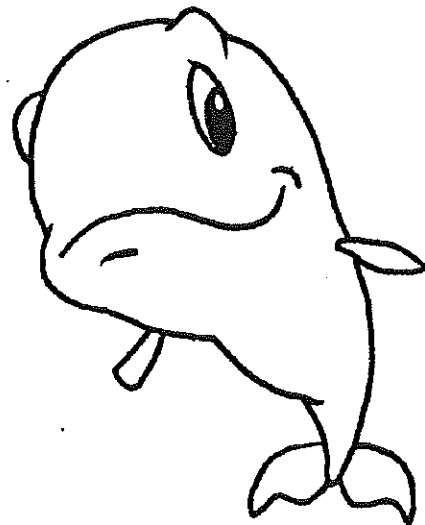
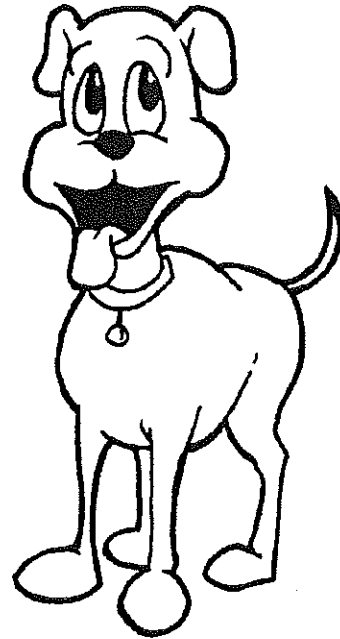

### When to use them:

- at the beginning of every sentence
- to begin the name of a special person, place, or thing
- to begin names of days, months, and holidays
- to begin titles of people (Mr., Dr., Captain)
- to begin names of clubs or companies
- to begin the first word and all important words in the titles of books, movies, TV shows
- for the pronoun I
